Computer-aided tutorials available in computer labs in Boyer Hall.

Here's how it works:

1. Go to Boyer Hall computer labs or the Landman Library and ask an Information Technology Lab Consultant or a Library Assistant to log you onto the system (you must show your Arcadia I.D. card and have an account on the Arcadia computer system.)
2. Arcadia alumni may use this system. If you don't have an Arcadia user's account call the Information Technology Department to have a personal account created. You must established a user account prior to using PLATO.
3. Instructions and technical assistance regarding the PLATO system will be available through the IT Department x2882.
4. PLATO is FOR MATRICULATED ARCADIA UNIVERSITY STUDENTS OR ALUMNI ONLY. Anyone found providing password information to non-Arcadia students will have their student computer privileges revoked.

We have limited access to the number of users that can use PLATO. When demand is high, users may not be able to log onto the PLATO system. Users should plan their usage of PLATO months in advance of taking these tests. **Don't wait until the last minute!**
