**GAME NOTES...** #2 Arcadia (14-1-3/6-1 CC) welcomes #3 Elizabethtown (9-9/4-3 CC) back to Glenside, just ten days removed from the Knights rain-soaked, come from behind 3-2 double OT win over the Blue Jays on 10-24. The winner of today's game will move onto Saturday's Commonwealth title game to face the winner of tonight's other semi final round game featuring #4 Albright @ #1 Messiah.

The Knights will look to front a well-balanced offense, outscoring opponents 40-10 during the regular season, with seasoned defensive back line led by first year keeper Jacki Law, whose .910 Save% and 10 shutouts leads the league. Arcadia is led by juniors Katie O'Malley (5G, 9A, 19pts) and Janelle Jablonski (7G, 4A, 18 pts), sophomore Stephanie Welch (7G, 4A, 18 pts), and juniors Stephanie Edson (5G, 2 A, 12 pts) and Dana Faulks (4G, 8 pts).

The Blue Jays enter today's win or go-home contest led by first year forward Laura Wingert (6G, 2A, 14 pts), senior Ellen Parr (2G, 3A, 7 pts) and first year Kelsey Boehmer (3G, 6 pts). Junior keeper Kristen Kelly (3-5 overall, 2 Shutouts) and first year Jess Manchak (6-4, 5 Shutouts) have split time defending the Etown net, and sport respective .99 and 1.50 Goals Against Averages.

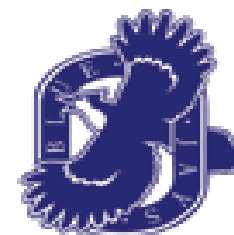
