

## JAMI RODRIGUEZ MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

The Jami Rodriguez Memorial Scholarship has been created in memory of Arcadia alumna, Jami Rodriguez (Class of 2000), to recognize the contributions current full-time undergraduates have made to campus life through dedication to community service. To apply, students must complete a scholarship application along with an essay that addresses their philosophy of service-- specifically, how their volunteer efforts have affected their lives and the lives of others. Evidence of volunteer work (references and/or documentation acceptable) and engagement in the life of the University community should be provided. Additionally, students must meet the following criteria:

- Be enrolled as a full-time undergraduate for the current semester and upcoming semester (preference will be given to Fine Arts students though others should apply)
- Have successfully completed a minimum of 57 credits at the time of application review
- Be in good academic standing and have a minimum cumulative Arcadia GPA of 2.0 at the time of application review
- Have demonstrated service and leadership on campus or in external communities

The award will not be automatically renewable though recipients may re-apply.

Applications for the 2009-10 year are due in Enrollment Management on April 15, 2009. Late Applications will not be accepted. Applications are reviewed by a committee consisting of the following: an SGO student representative chosen by the Vice President for Student Affairs and the Dean of Students, a Student Affairs Staff member, a member of the Rodriguez family, a student representative from New Student Orientation, the Director of Financial Aid, and the Coordinator of Community Service. Notification of awards will be made via mail.
