

# CHARLOTTE W. NEWCOMBE FOUNDATION SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

*The Charlotte W. Newcombe Foundation provides scholarship aid to adult women 25 years of age or older that have completed at least half of the coursework necessary for their bachelor's degree. Students must be matriculated on the undergraduate level to be considered for the award, which ranges from \$200 to \$2,000/year, and must be enrolled on at least a half-time basis (6 or more credits/semester). In addition, students must have a cumulative GPA of a 3.0 or better to apply. Selection is made on the basis of demonstrated financial need and outstanding academic record. Recipients are chosen and notified via mail by the Office of Enrollment Management. Applications must be submitted by June 1<sup>st</sup> for the coming academic year to Holly Kirkpatrick, Director of Enrollment Management/Director of Financial Aid, in the Office of Enrollment Management. Note that all information provided by applicant will be kept confidential.*
