Arcadia University Parking & Safety Information

Parking on Campus

All vehicles parked on campus or on campus-owned lots must be registered with Public Safety. A parking permit will be issued and must be displayed as instructed. Vehicles without current permits will receive a parking violation citation. All students, faculty and staff are expected to observe campus parking and traffic regulations and posted speed limits.

Driving Regulations

All motor vehicles and bicycles operated on any property of Arcadia University are subject to all provisions, rules, and laws set forth in the Pennsylvania Motor Vehicle Code and Arcadia University Parking Regulations. Violation of codes will subject the operator to fines and/or other disciplinary action.

What is the speed limit?

- The speed limit on roadways on the Arcadia University campus is 15 miles per hour.
- All students, faculty and staff are expected to observe campus traffic regulations and speed limits.
- The speed limit in campus parking lots is 5 miles per hour. Arcadia University has one-way traffic counterclockwise around campus.

Lot Designations

It is your responsibility to park in the appropriate parking lots.

- **Student:** Only A, R, C and S/OS permits allowed
- **Faculty/Staff:** Only F/S permits allowed
- **Visitor:** Temporary visitor permit (TPP) allowed
- **Open:** Any permit allowed

Motorbikes and Motorcycles

Motorbikes and motorcycles are subject to all of the regulations governing motor vehicles and must be registered with Public Safety.

Visitor/Guest Parking

A **visitor** is someone who comes to campus to do business, whereas a **guest** is someone that is here to visit a student.

Visitors and guests of the University must obtain a Temporary Visitor's Parking Permit (TPP) before parking on campus and must park in lots designated for visitor parking. Passes can be obtained from the Grey Towers Castle reception area or the Public Safety Office, located on the ground floor of Dilworth Hall.

Parking Appeals

You should only appeal a ticket if you believe you were not in violation or there were extenuating circumstances. Otherwise the ticket must be paid within 5 business days.

Appealing a Ticket

Individuals wishing to appeal a ticket or citation must contact the Public Safety Office within 5 business days of receipt of the ticket or citation to obtain an appeal form (available online or at Public Safety office).

Vehicle Immobilization/Booting

If your vehicle has been issued three or more parking violation citations, you are subject to having a vehicle-immobilizing unit (boot) placed on your vehicle.

Campus Safety Hints

- When walking after dark, keep to the lighted walkways.
- Avoid areas where shrubbery may conceal someone.
- When leaving your car, be sure to take your keys, removable valuables and lock your car doors.
- Do not leave personal property in plain sight.

Escorts

The Public Safety Department will provide escort services from one building to another and to and from the parking areas upon request of any member of the community.

To get an escort, contact Public Safety

- **Call 2900** from a campus phone.
- **Dial "O"** for the operator from a campus phone.
- **Use a call box**, located throughout many of our parking lots.
- **Dial 215-572-2900** from a cell phone or off-campus phone

Public Safety Office

The Public Safety Office is located in Dilworth Hall on the ground floor. Its hours are Monday–Friday, 8:30 a.m. to 5 p.m. The office has extended hours during the first weeks of each semester.
