Arcadia Names 2001 OUTSTANDING Athletes

Vince Abate and Katie Gallen, the Outstanding Male and Female Athletes from the Class of 2001, both established winning traditions during their time at Arcadia.

Abate, a native of Marlton, N.J., who graduated with a bachelor's degree in psychology, was a member of the first men's soccer team that won a conference playoff game and advanced to the Pennsylvania Athletic Conference Finals.

Abate was the soccer team's leading scorer and earned first-team all-PAC honors along with the University's first-ever spot on the regional All-American squad for a men's player.

In tennis, Abate was the number-one singles player and teamed with Mike Brewer '03 at number-one doubles. The duo went undefeated for two straight seasons, winning

the PAC Championship in 2000 and 2001.

Gallen has been a part of the women's soccer dynasty at Arcadia. The program won three consecutive PAC titles and earned a berth in the NCAA Tournament the

past two seasons. Gallen also excelled in lacrosse and will play another season of it while studying in the University's Physical Therapy Doctorate Program.

As a senior soccer player, Gallen served as a captain and earned the Coaches' Player of the Year Award. She also excelled in the classroom and was on the PAC's all-academic team all four years.

In lacrosse, Gallen missed a season while studying in Ireland. She served as team captain in 2001 and was named to the PAC's second-team all-conference. **H**
