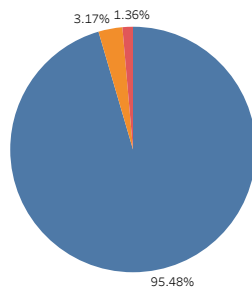


Graduation Outcomes - Overall University

Results based on findings from a Graduation Survey administered to graduate students by Arcadia University's Office of Career Education. The survey is readministered 6 months after graduation and students may update their outcomes at that time. Arcadia University faculty and LinkedIn are used to fill in any gaps of missing information. Combined, these sources give a picture of postgraduate outcomes for our graduates. For the class of 2017, Arcadia University had a knowledge rate of 59.4% (an outcome was known for 221/372 graduates).
