

Arcadia University's Graduate Program in Counseling
Annual Assessment of Program Effectiveness for the 2024-25 Academic Year

Description of Assessment

Each year, the Graduate Program in Counseling (GPC) evaluates its effectiveness in meeting its programmatic mission and objectives. This comprehensive multimethod evaluation system was developed by the GPC's core faculty and reviewed by the Master of Psychology and Counseling Accreditation Council (MPCAC) during the program's most recent reaccreditation cycle. Please see below for detailed results on all components of this annual evaluation system.

Summary of Findings

Results for the 2024-25 academic year indicate that the GPC was effective in meeting all targets. Specifically, the GPC met all defined targets regarding students' education and training in evidence-based counseling, multicultural competence, career development in counseling, and self-care.

2. The director and associate director will support new faculty in strengthening curriculum to emphasize competency areas noted in each outcome measure..

1. Goal: Graduates will demonstrate competency in evidence-based practice in counseling.

Core course: PY521: Research Methods, Design, & Evaluation

Measure: Second Reflection Paper

Students articulate a model of evidence-based counseling

Note: MPCAC: B.5.b.ii.1 & B.5.f Integration of research and evidence-based practice

Target: 80% of enrolled students will pass this assignment with a B or better.

Results: Target met: 100% of students passed this assignment with a B or better.

Measure: Final Exam

Students critique research and apply to treatment planning.

Note: MPCAC: B.5.b.ii.1 & B.5.f Integration of research and evidence-based practice AND B.5.b.ii.2 Conceptualization and Intervention

Target: 80% of enrolled students will pass this exam with a B or better.

Measure: Two Case Studies assignment

Students identify empirically supported treatment options.

Measure: Two Case Studies assignment

Students describe cultural variations in the presentations of mental illnesses and cultural biases in diagnoses.

Target: 80% of enrolled students will pass this assignment with a B or better.

Results: Target met: 100% of students passed this assignment with a B or better.

Core course: PY626: Assessment in Counseling

Measure: Test Presentation (Segments 1 & 2)

Students evaluate the multicultural sensitivity of testing instruments for a hypothetical client and interpret results based on fictional administration.

Note: MPCAC B.5.c Diversity

Target: 80% of enrolled students will pass these assignments with a B or better.

Results: Target met: 96% of students passed this assignment with a B or better.

Core labs: PY572L and PY688L: Multicultural Self-Awareness Labs

Measure: Six workshops delivered by multicultural experts to promote self-awareness of own identities, privilege, and biases

Students attend all labs and meet participation requirements (or meet make-up requirements).

Note: MPCAC B.5.c Diversity

Target: 100% of enrolled students will pass these labs with an S (Satisfactory).

Results: Target met: 100% of enrolled students will pass these labs with an S (Satisfactory).

Core labs: PY630L and PY631L: Multicultural Knowledge Labs

Measure: Six workshops delivered by multicultural experts on working with clients with various multicultural identities

Students attend all labs and meet participation requirements (or meet make-up requirements).

Target: 100% of enrolled students will pass these labs with an S (Satisfactory).

Results: Target met: 100% of enrolled students will pass these labs with an S (Satisfactory).

Core course: PY688: Cultural Bases of Counseling

Measure: Journal Writing

Students complete five journal reflecting on content from readings and lectures.

Note: MPCAC B.5.c Diversity

Target: 80% of enrolled students will earn B or better average across journals.

Results: Target met: 100% of students passed this assignment with a B or better.

Measure: Critical Interaction/Relationship Analysis

Students are asked to analyze a cross-cultural interaction and apply course concepts and how they could have interacted differently.

3. Goal: Graduates will display competency to pursue their specific careers in counseling

Core course: PY500: Educational and Career Counseling

Measure: Career Assessment

Students complete a career assessment through Arcadia's Career Office to gain knowledge of personal career skills, interests, and options.

Note: MPCAC B.5.e.i Methods of Evaluation and Assessment

Target: 80% of enrolled students will pass these assignments with a B or better.

Results: Target met: 100% of students passed this assignment with a B or better.

Measure: Current CV/Resume and Cover Letter

Students develop resumes and cover letters and seek feedback from peers.

Target: 80% of enrolled students produce resumes and cover letters and receive feedback from classmates.

Results: Target met: 100% of students received feedback from peers.

Core course: PY570: Professional Issues of Counseling

Measure: Mock/Informational Interview

Students complete a mock interview via Arcadia's Career Office or an informational interview of a professional working in the field.

Note: MPCAC: B.5.a Ethics

Target: 80% of enrolled students will pass these assignments with a B or better.

Results: Target met: 96% of students passed this assignment with a B or better.

Measure: Quiz on Pennsylvania Licensure Regulations

Students demonstrate knowledge of regulations to become a Licensed Professional Counselor (LPC) in Pennsylvania.

Note: MPCAC: B.5.a Ethics

Target: 80% of enrolled students will pass these assignments with a B or better.

Results: Target met: 87.5% of students passed this assignment with a B or better.

Core course: PY630 and PY631: Internship

Measure: Securing an Internship position by start of Fall semester

Students search and secure off-campus internship positions with the support of GPC administrators and faculty.

Target: 90% of enrolled students will secure an Internship position by the start of the Fall semester.

Results: Target met: 100% of students secured an Internship position by the start of the Fall 2024 semester.

Measure: Case Presentation (PY630)

Students provide a case presentation as if they were doing so for an interview or *job talk*.

Note: MPCAC: B.5.b.ii.1&2 Conceptualization and Intervention

Target: 80% of enrolled students will pass these assignments with a B or better.

Results: Target met: 100% of students passed this assignment with a B or better.

Measure: Process Recording Presentation (PY631)

Students provide a case presentation as if they were doing so for an interview or *job talk*.

Note: MPCAC: B.5.b.ii.1&2 Conceptualization and Intervention

Target: 80% of enrolled students will pass these assignments with a B or better.

Results: Target met: 100% of students passed this assignment with a B or better.

Measure: Interview of Distinguished Alum

Students conduct an interview of a recent alum of Arcadia's GPC to gather information about pursuing licensure and counseling careers.

Target: 80% of enrolled students will pass this assignment with an S (Satisfactory).

Results: Target met: 100% of students passed this assignment with an S (Satisfactory).

Measure: Professional Development

Students complete professional development activities (e.g., workshops, presentations, webinars, conferences, etc.) with the aid of their professional development fund.

Target: 100% of enrolled students will complete at least one approved professional development activity prior to graduation.

Results: Target met: 100% of students completed at least one approved professional development activity prior to graduation.

Measure: Successfully completing an Internship by end of the spring semester

Students complete their target hours and attend an Internship Seminar course.

Target: 90% of enrolled students will earn final grades of B or better in both PY630 and PY631.

Results: Targets met: 100% of students passed PY630 and 100% of students passed PY631 with a B or better.

Measure: Item: *Please rate the level of training you have received at Arcadia so far in each curricular area: Understanding and applying career development strategies to attain desired position in the field.*

Target: 80% of responding students with 30 credits or more will report Adequate to Excellent.

Results: Target met: 100% of respondents reported Adequate to Excellent.

Measure: Item: *Please rate the level of education you have received so far in each area: Understanding state requirements for licensure.*

Target: 80% of responding students with 30 credits or more will report Adequate to Excellent.

Results: Target met: 100% of respondents reported Adequate to Excellent.

Measure: Item: *Please rate the level of training you received at Arcadia in each curricular area: Understanding and applying career development strategies to attain desired position in the field.*

Target: 80% of responding alums will report Adequate to Excellent.

Results: Target met: 96% of respondents reported Adequate to Excellent.

Measure: Items: *Are you currently licensed to practice professional counseling in the United States (LPC or equivalent)?*

Target: 65% of responding alums who graduated at least three years ago (and indicated that their current or intended job requires a license) will report that they are currently licensed (LPC or equivalent).

Results: Target met: 78% of respondents who graduated at least three years ago (and indicated that their current or intended job requires a license) reported that they are currently licensed (LPC or equivalent).

4. Goal: Graduates will exhibit skills needed to incorporate self-care into their careers.

Core course: PY570: Professional Issues of Counseling

Measure: Self-care Plan assignment

Students design, implement, and track a personal self-care plan.

Note: MPCAC: B.5.a Ethics

Target: 80% of enrolled students will pass these assignments with a B or better.

Results: Target met: 100% of students passed this assignment with a B or better.

Core labs: PY572L and PY688L: Multicultural Self-Awareness Labs

Measure: Six workshops delivered by multicultural experts to promote understanding of the impacts of oppressions on self and others

Students attend all labs and meet participation requirements (or meet make-up requirements).

Note: MPCAC: B.5.a Ethics

Target: 100% of enrolled students will pass these labs with an S (Satisfactory).

Results: Target met: 100% of students earned an S (Satisfactory).

Program-wide policy: Personal Counseling Requirement

Measure: Personal Counseling (students matriculated in Fall 2017 and beyond)

Prior to starting PY630 (Internship), students complete at least six sessions of individual counseling.

Target: 100% of students enrolled in Internship will have completed their personal counseling requirement by having their provider submit a letter indicating completion of at least six sessions.

Results: Target met: 100% of students completed their personal counseling requirement prior to the start of the fall semester.

Program-wide evaluation: Biennial Student Surveys

Measure: Item: *Please rate the level of training you have received so far in each curricular area: Understanding and applying personal self-care for counselors.*

Target: 80% of responding students with 30 credits or more will report Adequate to Excellent.

Results: Target met: 100% of respondents reported Adequate to Excellent.
