Camilo López Delgado '15 is an Alumni Trustee who began his term on the Board in 2023. He earned a Bachelor of Arts inInternational Studies and Cultural Anthropology from Arcadia in 2015. and a Master of Arts in International Relations from New York University in 2017.

López Delgado moved to the United States from Paraguay for his studies. As an Arcadia student, he served as an orientation leader and led various clubs and organizations including the Amnesty International Club and the Arcadia Radio Club. In 2020, he was named to the University's 40 Under 40 list. In 2021, he served as the class representative during the 20th Anniversary Processional of the University.

López Delgado is a Government Relations Consultant for the United Nations Global Compact. His past roles include advisor to the United Nations delegations of Paraguay, Afghanistan, and the European Union, and research analyst at NYU's Center on International Cooperation. His portfolio has included issues on sustainable development, corporate sustainability, human rights, press affairs, international peace and security, and counter-terrorism.

López Delgado has also led a project on electoral information transparency in his native country of Paraguay and has contributed as a TV foreign policy/politics analyst on major networks in the country. He is also involved with initiatives seeking to support humanitarian efforts and the rights of the people of Afghanistan.
