

CHRISTINE KROLIK '79

Christine Krolik '79 was elected to the Board in 2024. She is currently serving as Mayor of the Town of Hillsborough, CA for the second time. She previously served on the Hillsborough City Council from 2004–2012, and was Mayor from 2008-2010, which included the Town's 2010 Centennial celebration. Christine rejoined the Council in 2020.

Christine and her husband, Jeff, raised their two sons in Hillsborough, and she was an active volunteer with the Hillsborough Schools. Christine was Concours Events Chair from 1999-2001, and co-chaired the successful 2002 school bond campaign. She was known for livening up parent group meetings by writing promotional songs for school events, sung with Liz Buljan and Michele Gutierrez. (They are celebrating 25 years together as the group Swing Set, and have performed the National Anthem for the SF Giants 16 times). Christine was named Hillsborough's Citizen of the Year in 2009.

Christine was on the Hillbarn Theatre Board of Directors, and served as its chair, and also chaired the board of what is now LifeMoves, previously Shelter Network. She is still active with both organizations. Christine is a member of the Burlingame Rotary Club, and is on its Board of Directors.

Professionally, she has worked on several campaigns for the incomparable Jackie Speier, serving as Finance Director for her 2006 statewide Lieutenant Governor campaign and for her first two campaigns for Congress.

Christine was born in Philadelphia and raised in Bucks County, Pennsylvania. She graduated from Arcadia University in 1979 with a BA in English and Theatre, and went back to teach there for a semester in 1983 when a theater professor was on sabbatical. After college, she trained at Circle-in-the-Square School of the Theatre and worked as an actress, teacher and director in New York. After she and Jeff relocated to the Bay Area, she worked at the Magic Theatre as Literary Manager. She still studies voice and performs cabaret for friends and charitable events.
